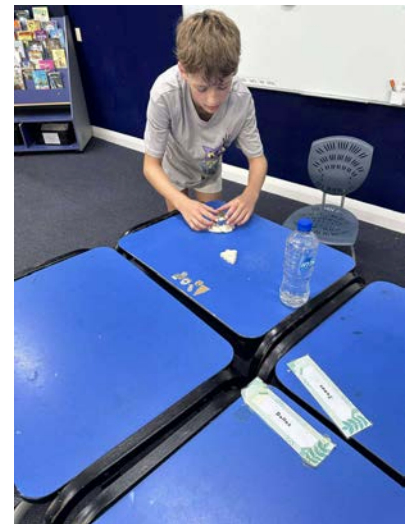
A massive THANK YOU to Miss Coleman for organising the Rangitoto School Christmas float.

CADETS SESSION

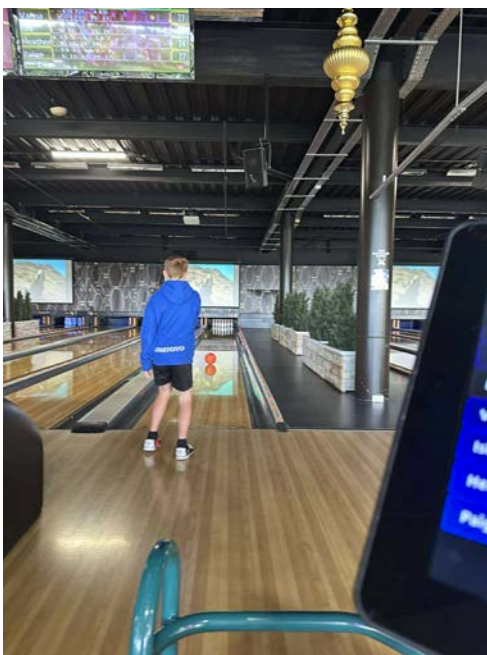
Mrs Reynolds held another successful Cadets session on Tuesday. The Junior room had a great morning making Christmas decorations.
