PRINCIPALS MESSAGE

Kia ora koutou

Welcome to Term 3! Staff have been excited to begin the term and we are looking forward to seeing both the academic progress of students and the creation of our whole school drama production 'The Rocky Monster Show' over the next few weeks. Parent support of students to assist them learning their parts in the play will be very appreciated. To help us out this term we welcome the addition of Mrs Mikayla Lord to the staff for the term. Mrs Lord will be working each Wednesday alternating between the junior and senior rooms and will be taking a key role in preparation of props for the production. A reminder that Mrs Signal will be in the junior room each Friday.

Miss Price enjoyed her first day in the senior class on Monday and I have had a lovely few days with them as well learning their strengths and areas to develop as we set teaching/learning goals for the term. Further to staffing, our participation in the Rural Schools Caretaking Scheme Pilot ends this month. We are therefore seeking a school Caretaker to work about 6 hours a week. We plan to have some information to pass on regarding Term 4 senior and junior camps very soon. Parents are welcome to start making online part payments towards camp costs - please make sure you put a reference of camp.

A reminder that our annual, and very popular, Ski Trip for Years 2-8 will be on the last Thursday of this term (18th September). This is an optional trip that costs \$55 per child with the remainder of costs subsidised by the Board of Trustees. Suitable warm waterproof clothing is compulsory. If students do not have this, then clothing will need to be hired for \$15 a student. A notice with full details and forms to return will be sent out in a couple of weeks but I wanted to give families, particularly those new to the school, a heads up about costs. To finish, I wanted to let our school community know that the Education Review Office will be conducting its next review of the school in Week 4 of this term. The ERO team will be in school from 5th-7th August and I will keep you updated on more details about their visit closer to the time.

A few updates relevant to school Health and Safety. Our new fire alarm system with both heat and smoke sensors is up and running and the school has practiced evacuating using the new system. A further change to improve our safety for students, is for all students leaving the school during school hours to sign out at the office on the sheet provided and sign back in if returning before the end of school day. This will ensure we meet our responsibilities to record student absences in case of emergencies and evacuations. The nomination process for our Rangitoto School Board elections has started and nominations are now open. We have appointed Schooled Election Pilot as the Returning Officer for the election, they will be handling the election process and you will see communications directly from them.

The info pack will contain everything you need to nominate yourself or another member of the community. (If you are going to nominate someone else, just make sure they know about it and will accept the nomination!). It will also include information who isn't able to be a School Board member.
