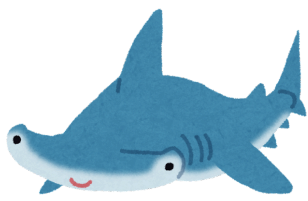

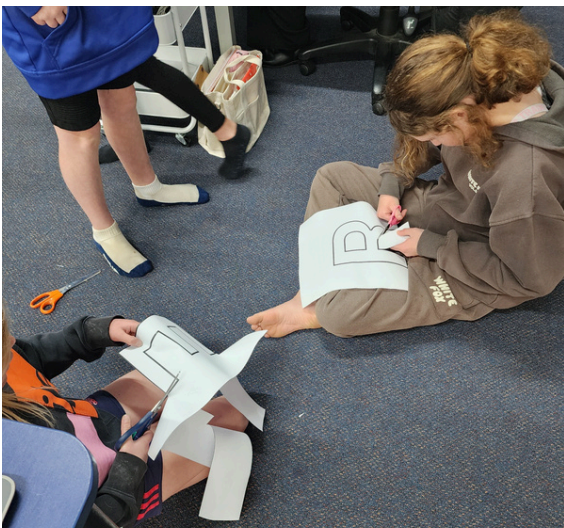

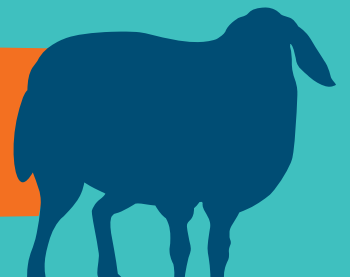
# PET DAY
