TARGA RALLY:

On Saturday 26th of October the Targa Rally will be in our area. We require 14 volunteers to help set up and marshal the event, we will then receive a generous donation from The Ultimate Rally Group. If you are available to help or require further information please let me know ASAP

This is a brief rundown of the job:

Volunteers will begin taping across people's driveways and gates from 6am - full info and equipment on this process will be given prior. Once the road officially closes at 8.15am we have safety vehicles that drive through the stage making sure everyone is in place and the road is safe for the cars to start. All volunteers are just required to stand in their assigned spots along the route until the race is finished. At the end of the race the officials will again drive through the stage and will let the marshals know that they can take down the tape and go home which is normally earlier than the assigned finish time 😊 We provide all of the safety tape, high vis vests, and training documents along with maps so that each Marshall knows exactly where to stand on the day.
