PRINCIPALS MESSAGE

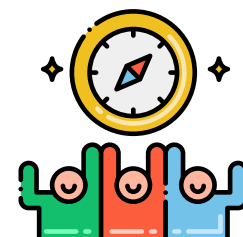
WEEK 8, TERM 2, 2024

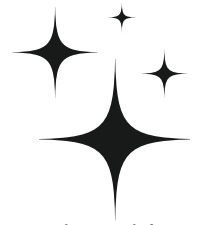

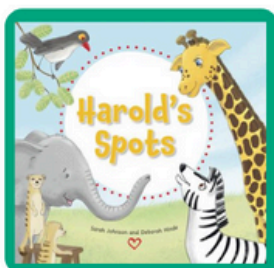

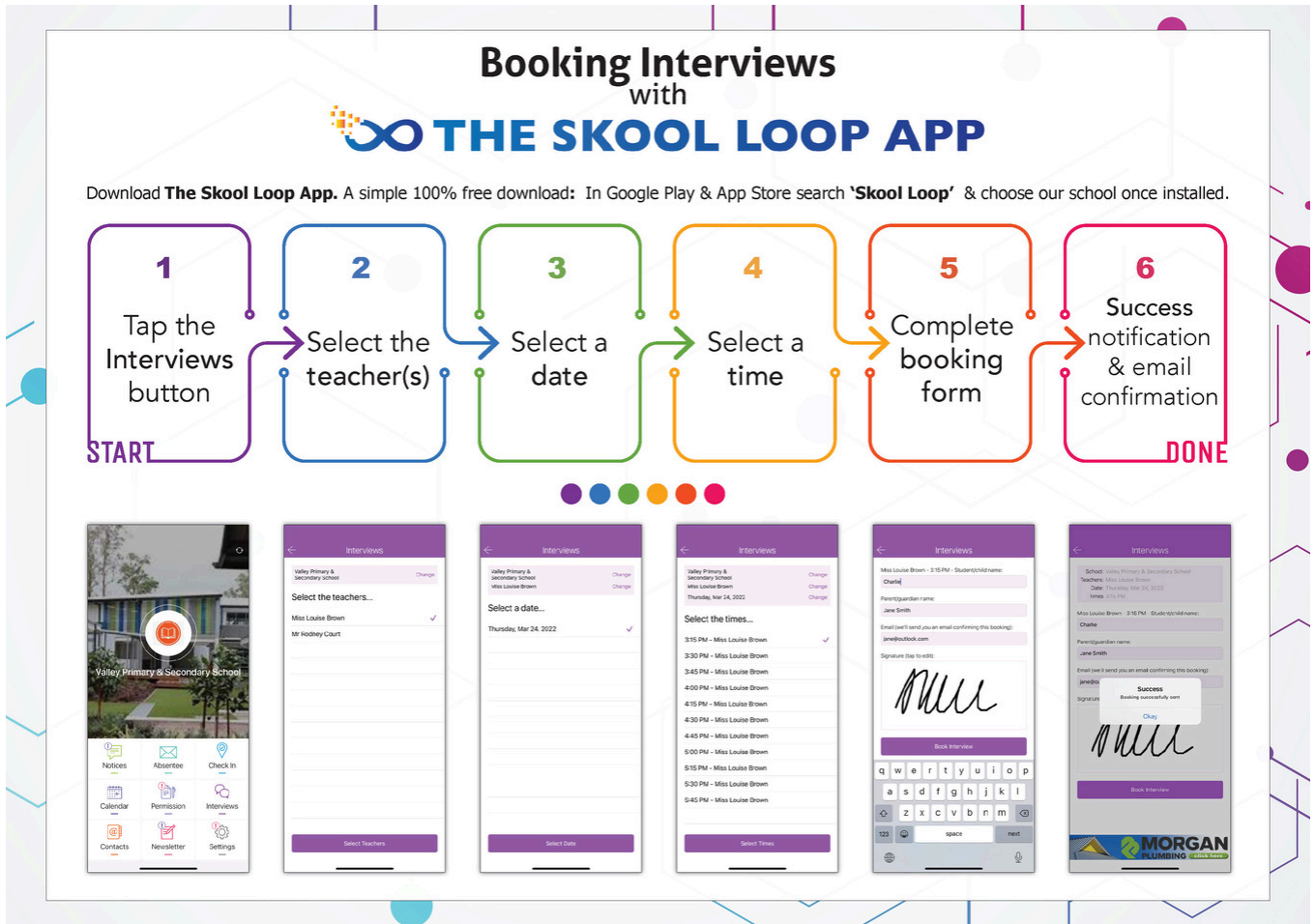
