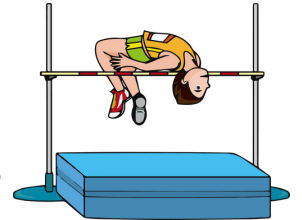
WEEK 6, TERM 4, 2024

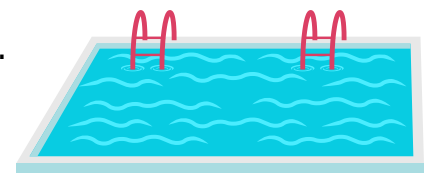
PRIZEGIVING 2024: This year our prizegiving will be held on Wednesday 18th December at 6pm.
